SITE WORK

The site work primarily involved cutting and clearing of brush and saplings and raking of the grounds, as well as the removal of moss and fungus from headstones using the product 'Wet and Forget'. The vegetative matter was put on the external-side of the stone walls for later pick-up and removal. Trustees used their own personal equipment for this maintenance.

A flat, rectangular stone that appeared to be about 14 inches by 15 inches and looked like it might have been used as a base-stone was found and soil was removed from the topside. This stone is near the west wall by a large tree-stump. The stone was left in place. Richard intends to research what this stone may have been used for.

Work at Sleeper #2 ended at 12:55 pm. All three Trustees, in their own vehicles, headed over to the Keyser Cemetery.
