Bunny Contest: Lucille picked up the prizes and is sending them out. Les said that Gina suggested that they do a picture in each town next year.

Summer Sponsors Update: We have five \$400 sponsors and one \$200 to date. Annie has one coming in.

## NEW BUSINESS

### Community Night Out:

- The date is June 29<sup>th</sup>.
- We will have Silver Circus at 5:30 pm.
- We will serve food at 6:15 pm.
- Lucille will follow up with Carroll Brown to make sure he can be there.
- Les will follow up on the climbing wall for that night and for Old Home Day. Les will also follow up with Paragon on the popcorn machine.
- Claire is sending out organizational letters to see if any groups want to set up a table that day. We want to see if the PD could do ice cream for the event. It could be just ice cream bars, popsicles, etc. if they don't want to scoop. It would be great if they could hand out something as well. We talked about the fluorescent dots to put on clothing as a possibility. We need to follow up with Chief Bean to see if he can get Josiah from Fish & Game there.
- Kim and Jeff Smith have said that they will cook again.
- If it is hot we should set up the misting tent. We discussed the possibility of having face painting, corn hole and other lawn games.
- It was also suggested that we may want to offer a vegetarian chili for those that don't eat meat. We could add nacho chips, salsa and cheese for those. We will set up from 4:30-5:30 pm.

- We need to find a tent company. Les will reach out to Lakes Region Tent Rental as she spoke with the owner last year. The cost will be higher. If we could get the tent set up on Thursday we could have it for the concert and do Candy Bar Bingo on Friday night.

Other: Cheryl did research on table carts and shared her info. We discussed that a table cart could damage the floor and we may want to keep stacking them.
