There is no formal presentation. You may arrive at any time.

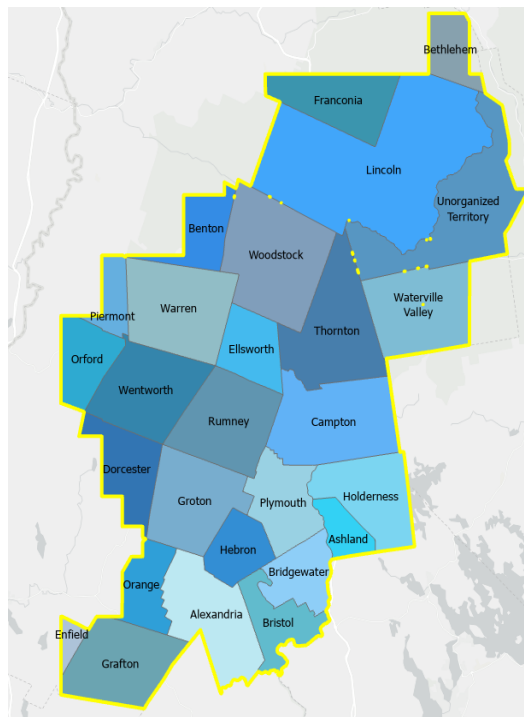
