Exterior siding is ongoing (weather permitting).

Framing of interior walls is complete on 1^{st} fl., will be completed on 2^{nd} fl. next week.

The electrical wiring will be complete on 1st fl. this week. Fire protection sprinkler piping is ongoing and will be completed in January. HVAC ductwork and plumbing rough-in will start in January, after wall framing. All will be completed by mid-February.

Spray foam insulation applied over the "firetop" is complete.

Overhead doors will be installed around the end of January.

Insulation of interior walls followed by hanging and taping of drywall will begin in February, completing in March.
