ARTICLE 3: EXPENDABLE TRUST FUND: TECHNOLOGY: Shall the Newfound Area School District vote to establish a Technology Expendable Trust Fund under the provisions of RSA 198:20-c for the purpose of purchasing, repairing, maintaining, replacing, and upgrading the District's technology related resources and to raise and appropriate up to the sum of One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000) to be placed in the Expendable Trust Fund: Technology, and to further name the School Board as agents to expend from the fund and to authorize the use /transfer in that amount from the undesignated fund balance available July 1, 2023 for this purpose?
(This article is not included in Article 4- Operating Budget).

ARTICLE 4: OPERATING BUDGET: Shall the Newfound Area School District vote to raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the "First Session", for the purposes set forth therein, totaling Twenty-Seven Million, Nineteen Thousand, Eight Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$27,019,875)? Should this article be defeated, the Default Budget shall be Twenty-Six Million, Nine Hundred Twenty-Two Thousand, Eight Hundred Nineteen Dollars (\$26,922,819) which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Newfound Area School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only.
